

Third Grade ELA Study Guide EOG Preparation

The third grade nine-week ELA test is going to be very similar to what students will see on the ELA End of Grade Test in May.

The Test Section of the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction has created practice reading portfolio passages for parents to use at home to reinforce the standards students will be responsible for at the end of the year.

Please use these passages as a practice tool for your child. In addition to working on these passages, you will be able to see the expectations set forth by the state, as well as, the types of questions and vocabulary used on this assessment. Students are required to complete six reading selections and questions on the ELA End of Grade Test. The test incorporates all of the standards of the practice portfolios.
