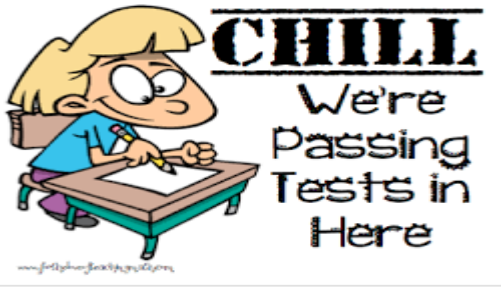

Their enrichment teacher, Mrs. Harnly, wrote a grant requesting funding to help students better understand real-world math applications. She used the allocation of funds to purchase items for the students and pay for a field trip to tour the bank and eat at Itza Boutza Pizza in Camden. The students used a check register and recorded their "paycheck" for attending class and working on their financial literacy projects. Students were allowed to purchase items from the "Classroom Store". These transactions provided students opportunities to learn the proper procedures used to make debits and credits in their personalized transaction registers. Items in the store ranged from \$1 to \$10. Many **thanks to The Towne Bank of Currituck** for funding this Financial Literacy Math unit.
