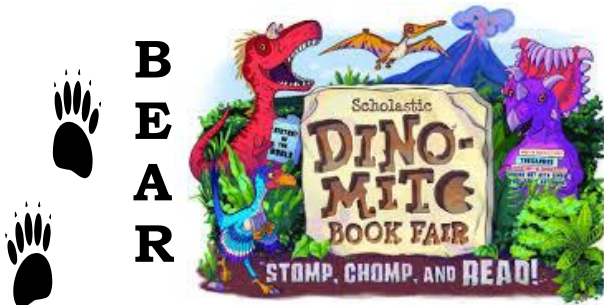

Or

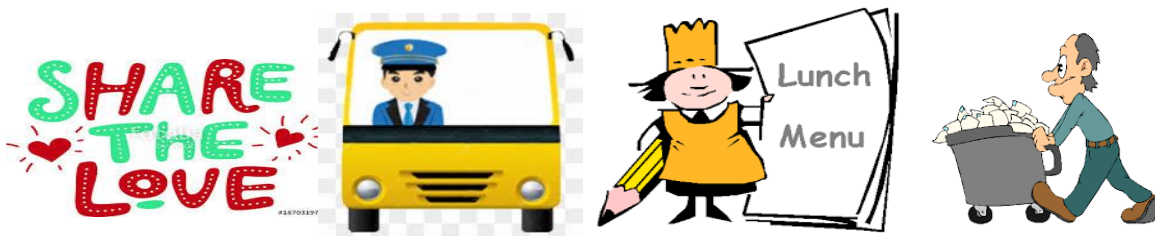
Create a 100 Day cape or item of clothing with 100 items on it
